Teaching Assistant Vacancies

Thank you for your interest in the teaching assistant positions advertised here at St Matthew's.

St Matthew's Primary School is looking for two teaching assistants to join our excellent team from 1st September 2022. The two roles we have available are:

 Level 3, Scale 7 to 11, 32.5 hours per week.
Monday to Friday, 8:30am to 3:20pm, term time only £20,043 to £21,695 per annum, (pro rata), (£10.21 to £11.05 per hour)

This role involves working with one of our Reception classes to support the class teacher and the children in the class to access their learning. You would also take on the role of leading teaching in the class while the class teacher has her Planning, Preparation and Assessment time (half a day per week) and on occasion cover the class if the teacher is absent. (Note when leading teaching you would be supported by an additional teaching assistant who would work in the class under your direction).

 Level 3, Scale 7 to 11, 32.5 hours per week.
Monday to Friday, 8:45am to 3:45pm, term time only £20,043 to £21,695 per annum, (pro rata), (£10.21 to £11.05 per hour)

This role involves supporting a child with special educational needs in a Reception class in the mornings and working as a key worker in our Nursery in the afternoons.
