3. Then, try to write sentences including each word pair.

e.g It was a very overcast morning

e.g. It was a very overcast morning, <u>however</u> the children still wanted to have a picnic.

- Make a poster to accompany your weather report including a map of the UK and label which areas of the country are 'overcast'.
