- Friday 29th March - Art Gallery for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6




Parents will have the opportunity to buy their children's artwork to raise funds for recycling bins for the school. More details will follow.

## Three Reminders

**Punctuality** – please remember that the start of the school day is 8:45am. We ask parents to ensure that their children are lined up ready to go into class just before this time. Arriving just before the gate closes at 8:55am means that your child is already 10 minutes late and not having the best start to their day.
