Level 3, Scale 5, Points 22 to 25 (£10.71 to per hour at point 22, £11.74 per hour at point 25).

Thank you for your interest in the post of Clerk to Governors. We think this is an exciting opportunity to join our team.

The position is a permanent position. The hours worked vary from month to month depending on the schedule of Governing Body meetings. There are usually about fifteen meetings a year, each lasting about one and a half to two hours each. They take place in the evenings, term time only. In addition to these hours, there is time for preparation for meetings, preparing papers, writing minutes (approximately four hours per meeting), as well as attending training and the termly clerks' briefings run by Cambridgeshire Local Authority. We will work with the successful applicant to agree the number of hours needed to carry out the required work.

St. Matthew's is an exciting place to work. Situated in the centre of Cambridge, just off East Road near the Grafton Centre, we are a community primary school (not affiliated to any church, despite our name) serving a very diverse community with over 25 different languages spoken by the children. In September 2011 we were judged to be outstanding by OFSTED, a great reward for all of the hard work we have done to raise standards of teaching and learning. I am proud that in doing this we have retained the existing strengths of the school – a strong, inclusive ethos; excellent pastoral care; a sense of innovation, adventure and fun. These characteristics are highly valued by our staff team, our children and our supportive parents. They mean that our journey of improvement has been one we have all enjoyed.

In recent years we have been growing and from September 2017 we will be a threeform entry primary school throughout.
